MEASURE PL

NO RECOMMENDATION

Pasadena Central Library earthquake retrofit, repair, upgrade measure

City of Pasadena would issue \$195,000,000 in bonds, levying \$28.90 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation of all properties in the city.

MEASURES PA, PB, PC

VOTE YES

Measures PA, PB, and PC, relate to changes in the selection of elected officials in case of vacancy, leadership roles among Councilmembers, and term limits.

MEASURE PF

VOTE YES

This measure aims to increase flexibility in selecting representatives for the Fire and Police Retirement System Board. This measure addresses difficulties in filling Board positions due to the aging membership of the retirement system.

MEASURE PR

This measure proposes amendments to the City's rent control ordinance.
